Mrs Finn's Message



Dear Parents

We all know these last two years have been very strange indeed. Normal routines and ways of doing things have changed. As a school, time has been given to reflect on how we could do things differently if there are tangible benefits to be had.

Such an opportunity to reflect has been given to our expectations regarding PE. We eliminated the need for children to change for PE and now ask children, on PE days, to come to school dressed in kit. The routine of changing often limited the time spent in lessons and could result in items of clothing being lost.

We now ask children, on PE days, to come to school dressed in kit, allowing children to enjoy more time engaged in physical activity. However, we need to again share our expectations regarding our PE kit. For PE, children need to wear a PE kit. PE days are not an opportunity to wear home clothes: our PE kit is- black shorts, blue/white t-shirt; tracksuit joggers or leggings (grey/black) and, if not a grey Rosemellin hoodie then a school jumper/cardigan must be worn.

We have high expectations in all that we do at Rosemellin. We expect the children to try their very best in learning and to be smart, not only in their attitude but also their appearance. This expectation includes our daily school uniform as well as our PE kit. Please support us in our uniform policy and, if you know items need to be replaced (including ties) half term may be the perfect opportunity for you to do so.

Enjoy half term and we look forward to seeing you again on Tuesday 1st March.
