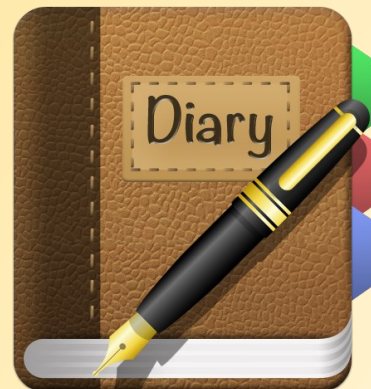

## **Children in Need**

## **Switch Off Fortnight**

Switch off Fortnight is an energy-saving campaign run by [The Pod](#). It encourages schools to educate children about their energy usage and to switch off appliances and lights when not in use.

By committing to turning off unused appliances and lights, the average school saves 10% of their typical energy usage. Saving money and helping reduce wasted electricity! At Rosemellin, we have set ourselves a challenge to reduce the amount of energy we use within school. We launched the challenge last week with the central team at Crofty MAT helping us to monitor our usage using the whizzy technology they have to record the data.

Energy consumption is related to a number of global warming factors, such as air and water pollution. Switch Off Fortnight is a great opportunity to raise awareness in the classroom about the effects of energy use on the environment. You may wish to set the same challenge at home.

## **Culdrose Cinema Trip**
