Please make sure your child's dinner money account is topped up with credit at the beginning of the week.

We can send you a reminder password or print a barcode for you to pay cash at a pay point if preferred. If your child is in arrears you will need to provide them with a packed lunch.

HOW IT WORKS:

In the morning your child will order a school dinner at registration time.

When they collect it from the canteen they will be marked off on the dinner list.

The office will deduct £2.65 from their account.



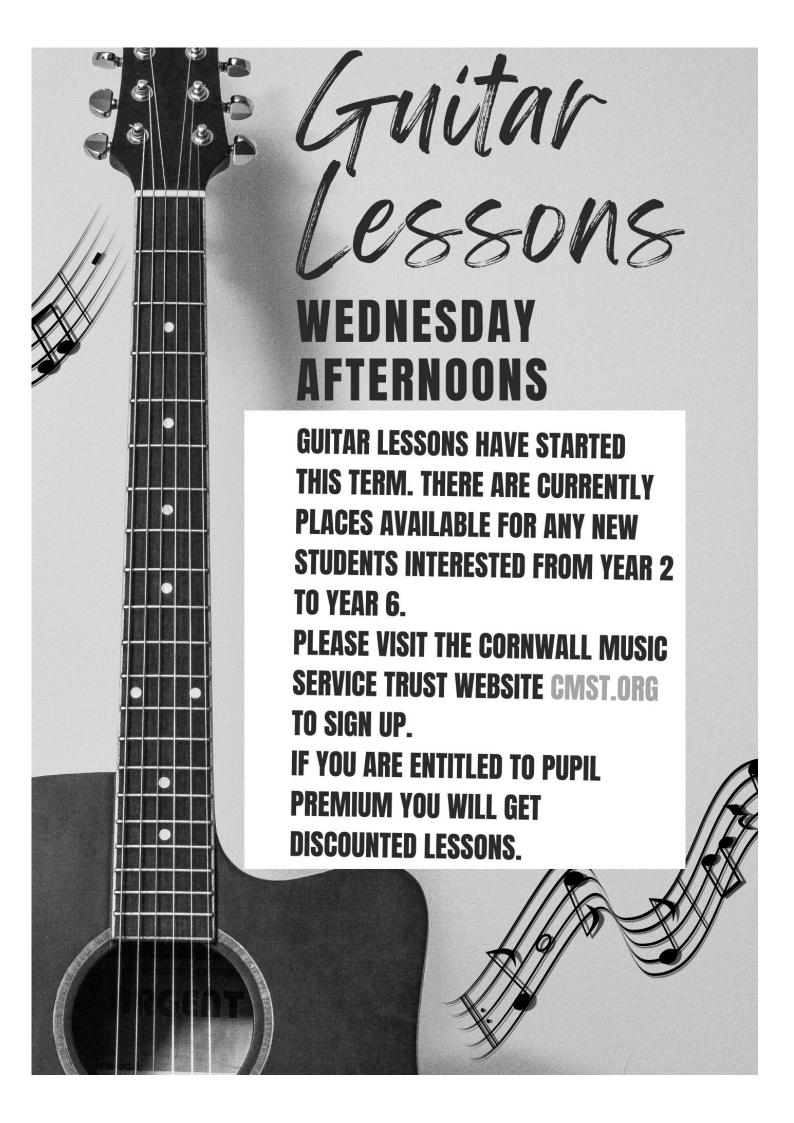


NO PARKING

15 January

Attending a nursery or pre-school

You will need to apply even if your child attends a school's nursery or pre-school class. Please note that if a school is oversubscribed the fact that a child attends a school's nursery or pre-school, or a local nursery or pre-school, does not automatically guarantee a place at that school. Obviously, if it is torrential rain, the staff will endeavour to open the doors earlier.

Please could I also appeal to you to not park in the school carpark (including the side road leading up to the reception area) unless you have made an arrangement with myslef of the school office. Many of our support staff are finding it hard to park in the mornings due to these areas being used by parents/carers. This is meaning that they can't always get into the classroom in time. This is equally important at the end of the day. Quite a few of our support staff need to leave school to then collect their own children and are finding themselves frequently blocked in.
