HOW IT WORKS:




Sports Day

School Uniform

As the academic year is coming to an end you may be starting to think about getting new uniform before the rush. We will continue to ask that children come to school in their PE kits when they have sports on that day. From September we will be insisting that children wear the correct PE kit as they represent the school. Please see the kit list below. Thank you in advance for your support in this.

The children have a PE lesson twice each week White or blue t-shirt Children wear their PE kit to school on their PE lesson day. However, in addition to this the children do lots of physical activities Plimsolls or trainers during the week so we advise school shoes that are suitable for Swimming costume & towel in named bag running and playing in. Black trainers are acceptable as long as they are plain black. Grey Rosemellin Hoody from Trophy Textiles It is essential for children to wear plimsolls or trainers for P.E. lessons. Different items may be needed for extra-curricular clubs such as shin pads, football boots, football socks and warm outside clothes for clubs held in the winter.
