

If your child is in arrears you will need to provide them with a packed lunch.

HOW IT WORKS:



Miss Sargent's Message



With two weeks until the end of term the school is a hive of activity.

The Year 6's end of Year Performance can be heard echoing around the school. I purposefully try to steer clear from rehearsals as much possible so that I get to see the finished, polished performance at the same time as the parents. This is such a memorable part of childhood and I still remember my final few days of primary school (which was longer ago than I care to believe). The journey through primary school is a special one where you form strong bonds with friends that you have known for years and the thought of secondary school, whilst exciting can be quite daunting.

Unfortunately, I've only had under a year to get to know the Year 6's but in that relatively short space of time I have been extremely impressed with their level or resilience, friendliness, hard working attitudes and drive to improve. I look forward to seeing them celebrate their time at Rosemellin over the next two weeks and know that there is a team of people in the background working to make this as memorable as possible.

Year 3 had their two day camp this week. On Wednesday, I spent the day dodging arrows, laser tags and Nerf guns and was surrounded by excitable, happy children. Following a camp over at school, they headed off for a day of fun on the beach. Lots of fun was had. Thank you to all the staff who gave up their time to organise this camp and sleep overnight at school. The seagulls were definitely the alarm for the morning! Rock Steady took place last week and was a great success. We have had 43 children sign up for the music lessons. These sessions do incur a cost (which is in line with or less than private music lessons) and we understand that not everyone will be able to access this provision. However, we felt that it was important to offer this in case there are any budding musicians within school who have not been able to source external music tuition. We continue to offer a range of music lessons within the school curriculum such as guitars, singing and using the other instruments within school.
