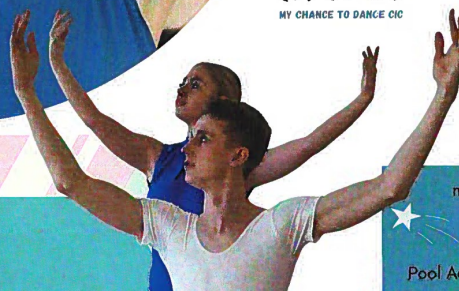
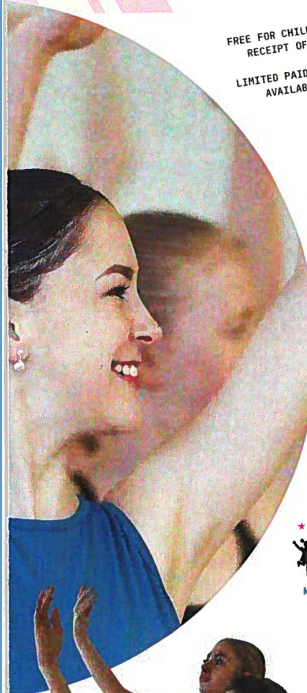

# Miss Sargent's Message



With two weeks until the end of term the school is a hive of activity.

The Year 6's end of Year Performance can be heard echoing around the school. I purposefully try to steer clear from rehearsals as much possible so that I get to see the finished, polished performance at the same time as the parents. Rock Steady took place last week and was a great success. We have had 43 children sign up for the music lessons. We continue to offer a range of music lessons within the school curriculum such as guitars, singing and using the other instruments within school.
