Please make sure your child's dinner money account is topped up with credit at the beginning of the week.

We can send you a reminder password or print a barcode for you to pay cash at a pay point if preferred. If your child is in arrears you will need to provide them with a packed lunch.

HOW IT WORKS:

In the morning your child will order a school dinner at registration time.

When they collect it from the canteen they will be marked off on the dinner list.

The office will deduct £2.65 from their account.



There are two representatives from each school and this half term's focus is to reduce the use of single use plastic bottles. Mrs Jones (Year 6 teaching assistant) leads this group and has spent a lot of time ensuring that we are working towards these pledges.

I will be delivering assemblies next week which will look at how, as a school, we can stop the use of single use plastic bottles. I briefly spoke to KS1 about the fact that I like to drink sparkling water throughout the day but this does mean that I use a lot of bottles. To over come this I had bought a Soda Stream (blast from the past) to make my own sparkling water. I'll be bringing it in to show them how it works. It would be great if you could discuss as a family how you could support this pledge. Maybe by using reusable water bottles.
