In the morning your child will order a school dinner at registration time.


When they collect it from the canteen they will be marked off on the dinner list.

Year 4 - Yellow


Year 5 - Orange



Miss Sargent's Message



Spring term (someone needs to tell the weather that it is now Spring) has been filled with lots of learning, activities and events.

Congratulations to those children who have achieved a CARE medal or badge. It is wonderful to see them proudly parading around the school wearing these. We had some people from Crofty MAT and heads from other Crofty schools visit this week and they were really impressed with how well the children could talk about the meaning of CARE and how it fits into our curriculum. We are looking forward to awarding more of these in the Summer term. Some of our Year 3 pupils confidently spoke to them about their Geography learning and were able to discuss the key things they had learned. We have been working really hard to plan our curriculum, identifying the main facts and skills that will help them develop their understanding in each foundation subject. We call these our footsteps.

Y3 Geography – Unit 3 Forests of the World

The three major forest biomes are: temperate, tropical and boreal forests. They occur at different latitudes.

Tongass National Forest is a temperate forest in Alaska, North America. The Amazon is a tropical forest in South America.

The day length, temperature and levels of rainfall are different in The Amazon Rainforest and Tehidy Woods.

First hand data collection is used by Geographers to help understand the differences and similarities in places in the world.

Another highlight of this term was watching the Year 3 and 4's at the Hall for Cornwall performing with Will Keating. There were approximately 1000 children from different schools who had practised a variety of songs. It was absolutely incredible to listen to them all singing at the top of their voices. I think I can safely say that every adult had a lump in their throat when they sang Cornwall my Home.

Walking around the school, we could spot lots of Dragon's tails. This was linked to year 2's book 'The Dragon Machine.' Their mission was to find the missing dragons. They were really enthusiastic about this and it produced some very creative writing.

A BIG thank you to our PTFA who arranged some fantastic fund-raising events this term. The children loved trying to find Daisy's paw print in the Rosemellinicious chocolate bars and the Easter Egg raffle was organised so well that every child won a prize of some kind. Egg rolling was a massive hit and I loved seeing all the different creations: Egg Shearan, a cactus, Eggpool and even Mr Cromey in a bath of slime! These events help to raise funds for lots of different things across the school – thank you to all of those who volunteer their time to make this happen.

I wish you all a fabulous break and look forward to our Summer term together.
