



Y1 Geography – Unit 1 What on Earth?

1) The Earth is a sphere and can be represented on a globe or a map.

3) On a map, globe or ariel photograph, the North Pole can be found at the top, the South Pole at the bottom and the equator around the middle.

5) We live between the North Pole and the equator where it is sometimes hot and sometimes cold.

2) The equator is an invisible line around the middle of the globe that separates the North and South.

4) It is always cold at the North and South Pole. It is always hot around the equator.



Y1 Geography – Unit 2 Where in the World are we?

1) We live in England which is part of the United Kingdom and can be found on a map/globe.

3) The capital of England is London.
The capital of Northern Ireland is Belfast.
The capital of Scotland is Edinburgh.
The capital of Wales is Cardiff.

5) Summer – it gets lighter and plants begin to grow. Summer – it can be sunny and hot.
Autumn – the leaves change colour and fall off the trees. Winter – it can be cold and icy.

2) The 4 countries in the United Kingdom are:
England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.

4) We go to school in a town called Camborne which can be found on a map of Cornwall.

6) The temperature and weather in Cornwall changes at different times of the year due to the 4 seasons – spring, summer, autumn and winter.



Y1 Geography – Unit 3 What is the difference between physical and human features?

1) Physical features like seas, mountains and rivers are natural. They would be here even if there were no people around. Human features are things like, houses, roads and bridges. They have been built by people.

3) The coast is the barrier between sea and land. This can be seen on maps and photographs.

5) The physical features of Portreath beach are: sand, pebbles, cliffs, rocks and rock pools. The human features of Portreath beach are: steps, harbour wall, surf lifesaving club house.

2) In the town of Camborne, there are more human features than there are physical features.

4) The key features of a beach are: sand, pebbles, rocks, sand dunes, cliff and caves. However, not all beaches have the same features.

6) Camborne town has more human features than physical features. Portreath beach has more physical features than human features.
